**Tasting Notes:** Named for the elevation of our estate wine cave in Amador County, 1646 is a barrel selection of Barbera and estate fruit of Zinfandel, Primitivo, & Petite Sirah. Dark stone fruit, holiday spice, and bright cherry develop into a smooth finish with a full-bodied mouth feel.
