WINEMAKER NOTES





This is an inky blue purple wine with a slightly smoky nose. The flavors of dark red fruit, plum and cherry dominate. It's full bodied, complex in flavor, showing ripe plum, blackberry and hints of spice and tobacco. The silky mouth feel is in contrast to the soft tannins. It finishes long and juicy.

VINEYARD & VINTAGE

Our 2.2 acres of Estate Grown Primitivo is head-trained and pruned to six shoots with two buds per shoot. The Primitivo is usually the first red to come off the property for harvest every year.

Bella Grace is named for the family's grandmothers, Bella and Grace, and captures their zest for life and unique character. At an elevation of 1646 feet, our Amador County estate vineyard is situated in the most historic winegrowing region of California.


