WINEMAKER NOTES

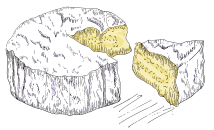
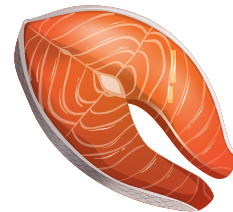
Sauvignon Blanc is always a great wine at Bella Grace and this one is no exception, in fact it is exceptional. The nose is beautiful with ripe melon and honeysuckle notes. The silky mouth feel is enhanced by the way the wine drapes itself over the palate. There is a burst of flavor across the palate with good balanced acidity. The finish is long and juicy.

VINEYARD NOTES:

The Linsteadt Vineyards is a neighboring vineyard, noteworthy for Sauvignon Blanc grapes. The block used for the Bella Grace vintages is among the youngest on the vineyard, ripens first, and produces fruitful flavors.

The vines are on a two-wire trellis system, east/west directional with an average canopy. Vines are pruned to low yields and thinned during the final ripening stage to improve quality. The 2020 Sauvignon Blanc grapes were harvested earlier this year, but still predawn hours under lights. Harvested to best promote the fruit and bright acidity of this classic Amador Sauvignon Blanc.
