

## 2022 Estate Bella Rosé Amador County



Blend: 60% Estate Grenache 40% Estate Mourvèdre

Vineyards: A blend of two estate Rhone varietals that originated out of a

"happy mistake" on our first Bella Rose vintage. The 2022 harvest was extremely hot through August, leading us to harvest the Grenache under the stars on the night of September 6th, 2022. After the early high temps, the weather cooled and delayed the harvesting of the Mourvèdre into the

second week of October of 2022.

Winemaking: Picked before their red counterparts at lower brix levels, they

were fermented and aged separately. With minimal skin contact, loads of dry ice, and a whole cluster press process, these two hand-crafted Rhone rosés provide the perfect

balance of acidity, crispness, and body.
