Blend:

Grenache Noir, Mourvèdre, and Rolle

Vineyards:

A blend of three Rhone varietals that originated from a "happy mistake" on our first Bella Rose vintage.

With wet conditions throughout the spring and milder weather throughout summer and fall, the grapes took much longer to ripe. The long ripening season has produced excellent quality and will make some of our best wines.

Winemaking :

Picked before their red counterparts at lower brix levels, they were fermented and aged separately. With minimal skin contact, loads of dry ice, and a whole cluster press process, these two hand-crafted Rhone rosés provide the perfect balance of acidity, crispness, and body.
