Winemaking & Aging:	Our vineyard is located in Plymouth, CA, at an elevation of 1,550-1,700, where our soils are primarily sandy clay derived from granite. We plant organic cover crops with organic compost in the winter, and then we can sow the green matter back into the soil during the spring. Harvested from four clones - Hambrecht on St. George Rootstock, Shenandoah Zinfandel on 110R Rootstock, Dempel Clone on St. George Rootstock, and Deaver on 110R Rootstock.

Tasting Notes:	Harvested from our estate property, the 2019 Amador Zinfandel boasts an opaque burgundy color and exhibits nice weight and viscosity. The nose is rich with ripe red fruit, inviting you into a well-structured wine with soft tannins. The palate reveals layers of bold, juicy flavors that linger beautifully, leading to a long, lingering finish. This Zinfandel is both rich and refined, offering a true taste of Amador terroir with every sip.
